

## **Amendment to NAC 116A**

### **To Update a Licensed Community Manager's Board Election Responsibilities**

**NAC 116A.016 "Board Election Responsibilities" defined. ([NRS 116A.200](#))**  
**"Board Election Responsibilities" means the duties of a licensed Community Manager to oversee and/or conduct association board elections so they are designed, conducted, and results certified trustworthy by a background cleared individual with no conflicts of interest in the outcome of the board election.**

**NAC 116A.046 "Election System Characteristics" defined. ([NRS 116A.200](#))**  
**"Required characteristics of such trustworthy board elections will be (a) verifiable audit trails in all ballot processing steps, (b) chain of custody records on all individuals handling ballots and other sensitive election materials, (c) use of high security locks and tamper-evident security seals on containers holding ballots, and (d) restricted access to ballots and containers to a single, trusted individual. Provisions will be included for board candidates to be able to openly inspect, review, and challenge the integrity of election activities before, during and after a board election before a judge, independent mediator or arbitrator.**
