ORDER CONTINUING CASE

This matter came on for hearing before the Commission for Common-Interest Communities and Condominium Hotels, Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Commission"), during a regular agenda on November 16, 2016. The Respondent, Rosario Orozco ("Orozco") (CAM.0007435), appeared through her attorney, Richard Haskin, of Gibbs, Giden, Locher Turner Senet & Wittbrodt LLP. Michelle D. Briggs, Senior Deputy Attorney General with the Nevada Attorney General's Office, appeared on behalf of the Real Estate Division of the Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Division"). Mr. Haskin and Ms. Briggs presented to the Commission their agreement to a continuance of the matter in exchange for Orozco paying to the Division an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,000 to be paid in 4 monthly payments of \$500 beginning on January 1, 2017.

3 The next Commission meeting is currently scheduled for March 7-9, 2017.


