ORDER

This matter came on for hearing before the Commission for Common-Interest Communities and Condominium Hotels, Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Commission"), during a regular agenda on March 6, 2018, at the Nevada State Business Center, 3300 W. Sahara Avenue, Nevada Room, Suite 400, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102 with videoconferencing to Department of Business & Industry, Director's Office, 1830 East College Parkway, Suite 100, Carson City, Nevada 89706 (the "Hearing"). Richard Haskin appeared on behalf of Vistana Condominium Owners Association, Larry Fitch, Anthony Kneip, Lynn Williams and Ardyce Nelson (the "Respondents"). Respondent Kneip and community manager Lynn Blaylock also appeared. Michelle Briggs, Senior Deputy Attorney General with the Nevada Attorney General's Office, appeared on behalf of the Real Estate Division of the Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Division").

Pursuant to the Commission's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order dated September 19, 2017 (the "Order"), the Respondents were to report on the status of their progress of the requirements in the Order.

The Order required payment of an administrative fine no later than January 1. 2018. The board members had not paid the fine nor made any attempt to make a partial payment.

The Association's attorney represented that the board members completed 9 hours of board education classes offered by the Division, but did not provide written verification.

The Association's manager reported on her status of refunding owners who paid a fine when their vehicles were towed in August 2014.

After discussion and deliberation, the Commission, by unanimous vote, ordered as follows:

- 1. RESPONDENTS LARRY FITCH, ANTHONY KNEIP, LYNN WILLIAMS, and ARDYCE NELSON shall each, individually pay the administrative fine as previously ordered totaling \$5,128.40 by paying \$100 per month, due on or before the first of each month, until the full amount of the total fine is paid. The first payment is due on or before April 1, 2018.
- 2. The Association shall send out in its next monthly newsletter notice to all owners and residents that if anyone paid a fine as a result of their vehicles being towed in August of 2014 to contact the Association for repayment.
