To: The Nevada Real Estate Commissioners,



Being aware allows everyone the opportunity to prepare, be vigilant to all our clients and your personal/our agents' safety.

I request that you consider this class for general credit so we don't have the same tragedy in Nevada as Arkansas did with the death of an agent that if had been more aware of the situation may have not been in danger and would have met the potential client in the office, got I.D. and had others to view her attacker.

Giving this class general credit assists us all in protecting the agents and their clients from potential harm. In 2013, this same class under CE.5431000-RE was approved for 3 hours of General Credit.
