I would like to adjust the system in the hopes of not only helping myself but others who have similar disabilities in order to make the opportunities equal for all those who enter this profession. My last class, I attended a wonderful Steve Kitnick Seminar for Continuing Education, and luckily I managed to keep up with and the information included only because it was a very small class. I did miss out on a few concepts when he turned around and faced the chalkboard, therefore, I was unable to read lips, I am writing to you to ensure this no longer occurs. As mandatory, I have to do 12 hours of in class room courses and elected to take 12 hours of online education since I do not fully grasp the in class sessions, extra work, time and money I otherwise would not have to spend. I called GLVAR to see if they have assistance in this type of programs such as note taking or someone to sit with you in class to make sure you comprehend the information or even take the full 24 course on-line. The response I got was: NONE. Neil Schwartz suggested that I contact you to request to have this item put on the agenda for the next meeting of the Real Estate Commission. Please consider granting me an exception to taking 12 classroom hours and to allow permission to take all CE requirements online.
