## AMENDED ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION OF FACTS AND LIABILITY

## **AND DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

This matter came on for hearing before the Nevada Real Estate Commission, State of Nevada (the "Commission") on December 11, 2013, at the Grant Sawyer Building, 555 E. Washington Avenue, Room 4412, Las Vegas, Nevada (the "Hearing"). Respondent Sharon (Dylan) Shina (the "Respondent") personally appeared at the Hearing along with his legal counsel, Sigal Chattah, Esq., of the Law Offices of Sigal Chattah. Christopher Eccles, Deputy Attorney General with the Nevada Attorney General's Office, appeared on behalf of the Nevada Real Estate Division, Department of Business & Industry, State of Nevada (the "Division," and together with the Respondent, the "Parties").

The Commission, having considered the testimony and the evidence introduced by the Parties and being fully advised, enters the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order. Under Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 645, the Commission has legal jurisdiction and authority over this matter.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

The Commission, based upon the evidence presented during the Hearing, finds that there is substantial evidence in the record to establish each of the following Findings of Fact:

1. The Parties presented a Stipulation of Facts and Liability Regarding Complaint for Disciplinary Action (the "Stipulation") wherein, in pertinent part, the Respondent admitted that all

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- 13. The Respondent shall pay to the Division a total fine of \$115,000.00. The Respondent shall make an initial payment of \$1,916.47 within 90 days of the effective date of this Order, and \$1,916.67 a month thereafter, until paid in full.
- 14. The Division may institute debt collection proceedings for failure to timely pay the total fine, or any installment or portion thereof.
- 15. The Respondent shall appear before the Commission if he ever applies for any license from the Division.
- 16. The Commission retains jurisdiction for correcting any errors that may have occurred in the drafting or issuance of this order.

This Order shall become effective on the 19th day of October, 2017.
