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12 **ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

13 This matter came on for hearing upon Respondent's Petition for Reconsideration/Request for
14 Extension ("Petition") before the Commission for Appraisers of Real Estate of the State of Nevada (the
15 "Commission"), during a regular agenda on July 18, 2023, in Las Vegas, Nevada and by video
16 conference. Alfonso Camino, Respondent, appeared on his own behalf. Phil W. Su, Esq., Senior Deputy
17 Attorney General with the Nevada Attorney General's Office, appeared on behalf of the Real Estate
18 Division of the Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Division"). In support of
19 his Petition, the Respondent also submitted supporting documentation consisting of medical records.

20 On April 4, 2023, the Commission considered and accepted a proposed Stipulation and Order
21 for Settlement of Disciplinary Action jointly presented by the Division and Respondent. The Stipulation
22 set forth, among other terms, that Respondent would pay the Division \$5,400.00 in fines, costs, and
23 fees, in the form of fifteen (15) monthly payments of \$363.33, with the first payment due thirty (30)
24 days after approval of this Stipulation by the Commission. The Respondent has made two payments to
25 date, but due to a Medical Emergency as set forth in his Petition, he has requested an extension of six
26 months until he is required to make his next scheduled payment.

27 Based on the Respondent's representations in his Petition and supporting documentation, the
28 Commission hereby orders that the Petition is GRANTED, as follows:

- 1) Respondent Camino is granted a six (6) month extension, from the effective date of this Order, until he is required to make his next monthly payment of \$363.33 pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation and Order for Settlement of Disciplinary Action;
- 2) Respondent Camino is granted a six (6) month extension, from the effective date of this Order, to complete the additional Continuing Education Credits ("CEC") from the original deadline as set forth in the Stipulation and Order for Settlement of Disciplinary Action;
- 3) All other terms of the Stipulation and Order for Settlement of Disciplinary Action will remain unchanged.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
