Once the required number of signatures are obtained, the petition must be mailed, return receipt requested, or served by a process server to the executive board or community manager for the association in order to initiate the next steps in the removal process.

## **EXPECTATIONS**

No one shall:

- Cross out, alter or modify any information on the petition
- Circulate a petition that is not in its entirety
- Misrepresent the contents of the petition
- Fraudulently sign a petition for another person or forge any names
- Permit others to commit unlawful/fraudulent activities regarding the petition
- Encourage minors or ineligible individuals to sign the petition
- Offer a form of payment in exchange for signatures
- Use intimidation or untruthful statements to garner signatures

The association shall not adopt any rule or regulation which prevents or unreasonably interferes with the collection of the required percentage of signatures for a recall petition.
