23	4.	The basis of Respondent's Petition for Rehearing concerns the imposition,
24		pursuant to NRS 622.400(1), of \$17,183.91 in hearing and investigative costs,
25		by the Commission in its July 2, 2021, Findings of Fact and Conclusions of
26		Law.
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- On or about July 19, 2021, the Respondent filed his Motion to Stay Enforcement of Order Pending Ruling with Respect to Respondent's Petition for Rehearing.
- Pursuant to NAC 645C.505(6), the Division may stay enforcement of the decision being appealed when the Commission is not scheduled to meet before the effective date of the penalty.
- 7. The effective date of discipline in this matter is stayed until the date of the Commission's order ruling on the Respondent's Petition for Rehearing.
- 8. Pursuant to NRS 645C.520, because the Commission's underlying Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law did not impose discipline in the form of a revocation, suspension, or denial of renewal of Respondent's certificate, license, or registration card, the date of the Commission's order ruling on the Respondent's Petition for Rehearing shall be the effective date of the discipline therein, should the Commission deny the Respondent's Petition for Rehearing.
