ORDER

This matter came on for hearing before the Commission for Common-Interest Communities and Condominium Hotels, Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Commission"), during a regular agenda on June 19, 2018. The Respondent, Pecos Creek Homeowners Association, appeared through their community manager, Jonathon Kelly. Michelle D. Briggs, Esq., Senior Deputy Attorney General with the Nevada Attorney General's Office, appeared on behalf of the Real Estate Division of the Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Division").

Pursuant to the Commission's Order filed March 13, 2018, in attendance before the Commission were current board members: Sherryl Baca, Ofelia Santos, and Andrew Dionne. The fourth board member could not attend.

Ms. Briggs reported to the Commission that this was on for a status check for the Association to report on its progress getting audits and a reserve study completed. Mr. Kelly provided a packet with an annual registration form and a registration filing addendum dated the same date, May 23, 2018. Mr. Kelly also provided a reserve study approved in 2017. The Association is underfunded approximately \$500,000 and approximately 15% funded.

Ms. Baca reported that a draft of the forensic audit would be provided to the

Association in July.
