ORDER REMOVING LUIS VILLAREAL FROM THE BOARD

Respondents Alan Mehr and Marc Morger appeared by video, no other Respondents appeared. Michelle D. Briggs, Senior Deputy Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the Real Estate Division of the Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Division").

Mr. Morger and Mr. Mehr confirmed that no action had been taken to hire a community manager and Mr. Villareal was not communicating with the other board members.

For good cause appearing, the Commission finds and orders as follows:

WHEREAS, RESPONDENT LUIS VILLAREAL knowingly and willfully failed to comply with this Commission's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order dated May 28, 2020; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of The Colony (the "Association), a common

1	interest community in the State of Nevada, for RESPONDENT LUIS VILLAREAL to be
2	removed from the Association's board of directors and as an officer.
3	THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that RESPONDENT LUIS
4	VILLAREAL is immediately removed from the Association's board and as an officer of
5	the Association for no less than 10 years from the date of this Order.
6	IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Association shall hire a community
7	manager on or before October 1, 2020 and the Association's community manager shall
8	report to the Commission at its October 27-29, 2020 meeting.
9	The Commission reserves the right to impose additional discipline.
10	IT IS SO ORDERED.
