24	Pursuant to the Commission's Order filed April 1, 2025, the RESPONDENT appeared at the	
25	Commission Meeting to address its breach of the Order Terms Nos. 3and 5.

12	5. The Commission retains jurisdiction for correcting any errors that may have occurred in	
13	the drafting and issuance of this document.
