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14 **STATUS CHECK**

15 This matter came on for hearing before the Commission for Common-Interest Communities and
16 Condominium Hotels, State of Nevada (the "Commission") during a regular agenda set on a three-day
17 stack beginning at 9:00 a.m. on June 10, 2025 (the "Hearing"). Board President Christine Ramos
18 appeared on behalf of Daybreak at Sunrise Highlands Homeowners Association ("RESPONDENT"),
19 and reported that Board Members Treasurer Andy Ramos and Secretary Yoandry Sanchez¹ were unable
20 to attend due to work, also with Supervising Community Manager Ashley Leavens (CAM.0008646-
21 SUPR) and provisional community manager Crystal Rymer (CAM.0010497-PROV), and Lucille
22 Sanchez representing Complete Association Management Company ("CAMCO") (CAM.0009298-
23 SUPR). Christal P. Keegan, Deputy Attorney General with the Nevada Attorney General's Office,
24 appeared on behalf of the Real Estate Division of the Department of Business and Industry, State of
25 Nevada (the "Division").

26 Pursuant to the Commission's Order filed April 1, 2025, the RESPONDENT appeared at the
27 Commission Meeting to address its breach of the Order Terms Nos. 3 and 5.
