Prior to the commencement and conclusion of a contested case or a quasi-judicial proceeding that may affect the due process rights of an individual the board may refuse to consider public comment (NRS 233B.126).

Please be aware that after the quasi-judicial board or advisory review committee has rendered a decision in the contested case and assuming this happens before adjournment, then you may advise the board, commission, or advisory review committee that it may entertain public comment on the proceeding at that time.
