**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S REQUEST FOR  
RECONSIDERATION OF DISCIPLINARY TERMS**

This matter came back before the Nevada Real Estate Commission ("Commission"), State of Nevada, on March 15, 2017, at the Gaming Control Board, located at 1919 College Parkway, Carson City, Nevada 89701. Mary E. McQuattie ("Respondent"), appeared in person and testified at the hearing. Deputy Attorney General PETER K. KEEGAN appeared on behalf of petitioner SHARATH CHANDRA, Administrator of the Real Estate Division, Department of Business & Industry, State of Nevada ("Division").

At the conclusion of the hearing, the Commission considered Respondent's Request for Reconsideration of Disciplinary Terms, along with the arguments made by Respondent during the hearing. The Commission unanimously voted to grant Respondent's request for an extension of time to comply with the Disciplinary Terms of the Commission's Decision: Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, filed on November 2, 2016 ("Decision").

**ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, upon a unanimous vote, that Respondent is granted an extension of time to pay the Division a total fine of Thirteen Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Two and 94/100 Dollars (\$13,132.94). The total fine reflects a fine of Ten Thousand

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1 Five Hundred Dollars (\$10,500.00) for committing the above violations of law, plus Two  
2 Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Two and 94/100 Dollars (\$2,632.94) for the hearing and  
3 investigative costs. Respondent shall pay Two Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars (\$274.00)  
4 per month for 48 months, or until the fine is paid. Payments shall be made on the first  
5 day of each month, beginning June 1, 2017. The Division may institute debt collection  
6 proceedings for failure to timely pay the total fine.

7 The Commission retains jurisdiction for correcting any errors that may have  
8 occurred in the drafting and issuance of this Decision.

9 This Order shall become effective on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of MAY, 2017.
