**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION OF
DISCIPLINARY TERMS**

The Nevada Real Estate Commission ("the Commission") having previously entered a decision ("the Decision") after hearing on March 26, 201⁹, on the Complaint herein against Respondent Megan Barry, ("RESPONDENT") imposing a fine in the amount of \$25,000.00 and \$2,947.87 in investigative costs and attorneys' fees, to be paid within ninety (90) days of the effective date of the decision, which was May 18, 2019;

RESPONDENT having requested relief in the form in the form of a Petition for Reconsideration of Disciplinary Terms ("Petition"), asking for an extension of time to pay said fines, costs and fees;

The Commission heard RESPONDENT'S Petition on August 20, 2019 in the Nevada Room, 4th Floor of 3300 West Sahara, Las Vegas, Nevada, requesting said relief. At the hearing, the RESPONDENT was represented by Mr. Charles E. Gianelloni, Esq., and SHARATH CHANDRA, Administrator of the Real Estate Division, Department of Business & Industry, State of Nevada, represented by Deputy Attorney General Peter K. Keegan.

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1 At the conclusion of the hearing, the Commission voted 3-2 to modify the disciplinary terms such
2 that Respondent shall be required to pay \$10,000.00 of the amount owed no later than August 2019 and
3 \$2,500 per month thereafter until the remaining balance is paid.
