11 **DECISION AND ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING**

12 The matter of the Petition for Rehearing of Respondent Katherine Hunter ("Respondent"), came  
13 on for hearing before the Nevada Real Estate Commission, State of Nevada ("Commission") on Tuesday,  
14 August 20, 2019, at the Nevada State Business Center, 3300 W. Sahara Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada  
15 89102, relative to the Commission's Decision dated April 19, 2019. Respondent Katherine Hunter  
16 ("Respondent") failed to appear in her own behalf. Peter K. Keegan, Deputy Attorney General, appeared
