DECISION

This matter came on for hearing before the Nevada Real Estate Commission, State of Nevada ("Commission") on Wednesday, June 12, 2019, at the Nevada State Business Center, 3300 W. Sahara Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102. Respondent Roslynn Phoenix-Myrick ("RESPONDENT") failed to appear. Dennis L. Belcourt, Deputy Attorney General, appeared and prosecuted the Complaint on behalf of Petitioner Sharath Chandra, Administrator of the Real Estate Division, Department of Business & Industry, State of Nevada ("Division").

On the Commission's finding of proof of sufficient service, and the matter having been submitted for decision based upon the allegations of the Complaint, the Commission now enters its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

General Allegation

1. At all times relevant to this Complaint, RESPONDENT was licensed by the Division as a broker, Nevada license number B.1000600.CORP (expired), and B.1001579.INDV, and holds a property management permit, PM.0164860.BKR.

Guilty Plea and Conviction

2. On or about November 10, 2016, RESPONDENT was charged with "willfully and unlawfully (conspiring) to obtain property or services of another person by a material misrepresentation with intent to deprive that person of the property or services..."
