

5. Any other allegations not specifically responded to were inadvertently omitted and are further denied.

AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES

FIRST AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Respondent has not received any commissions or profits from the alleged transaction.

SECOND AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Petitioner has failed to state a claim for which relief or penalty may be granted.

THIRD AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Petitioner has suffered no legal damages.

FOURTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Plaintiff is not entitled to equitable relief.

FIFTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

The damages and violations alleged were due to the acts and omissions of other parties.

SIXTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

To the extent that a contract existed, the other parties, apart from Respondent, have not fully performed under the contract.

SEVENTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Petitioners claims are made without adequate substance, to such an extent that Respondent is entitled to an award of attorney fees and costs for defending this action.

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EIGHTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Petitioner has failed to mitigate their damages, if any.

NINTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Petitioner's Complaint is barred by the doctrine of laches.

TENTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Petitioner's Complaint is barred by the applicable statute of limitations.

ELEVENTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Petitioner's Complaint failed to allege conduct by or attributable to Respondent that actually or proximately caused any of the injuries or violations alleged in the Complaint.

TWELFTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

Respondent has been required to retain the services of 911 Law Group to defend against Petitioner's Complaint and is therefore entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs herein.

THIRTEENTH AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE -

To the extent applicable, Respondent incorporates by reference any and all affirmative defenses enumerated in Rule 8 of the Nevada Rules of Civil Procedure as if fully set forth herein for the purpose of not waiving them. In the event additional affirmative defenses become applicable, Respondent reserves the right to seek leave of Court to amend her Answer to assert them.
