Dear Commissioners;

I am very sorry to say but, as of this writing, I am not able to pay the fine of \$10,000 and Hearing Fees & Costs of \$4,936.34 by 6-18-20. I am informing you of this with hopes that you will allow an amendement to the order giving me more time to pay.

Given the current Pandemic conditions of COVID-19, I have not had income as usual. I have no current Escrows or projected Escrows or any dates of certainty as to when I will have any closings. I do not have enough money to even pay my current daily living expenses and mortgage.

Today, I beg your mercy on my future to retain the privilege of keeping my Nevada Real Estate License. The income from my License is vital to the survival of my family.

I am extremely sorry for all of my indiscretions with regards to this matter. The loss of my 2 Property Management Licenses and 2 Broker Licenses has been very humbling to say the least.

I beg and pray that you will have mercy on me and allow me to survive this.

My proposed amendment is for you to allow me up to 48 months with a minimum of \$250 due by the end of each month starting in July of 2020. If I have extra money, I will pay more each month. My remaining License is now with Berkshire Hathaway Home Services of Nevada at the Summerlin Office and I am hoping I will have good income potential there.

Thank you for your valuable time and consideration Commissioners. I deeply appreciate anything you can do to help me in my most difficult time of need.
