I would like to appeal so I can continue to provide Pre-Licensing, Post-Licensing & CE classes. I have been licensed in Nevada for 36 years.

In 2020, I was co-marketing a property for a long term client, with a Utah agent, as the property was in Brian Head. We had written consent from the broker. We had marketed the property in the Las Vegas MLS system with a disclosure that the listing agent was in Utah and we provided their contact info. The Utah Real Estate Division fined me for marketing property in a state I wasn't licensed in based on the MLS feed that distributed the property and did not pick up the disclosure that it was listed with a Utah agent. We had no idea that information would not be shared, and removed it as soon as we found out.

In 2020, when I went to renew my broker's license I answered the question about fines and disciplinary actions as no - thinking I hadn't had anything. I had no idea that the Utah incident would affect me. Jan called me and told me it was an automatic fine, which I paid.

I appreciate your time and consideration on this appeal.
