ORDER CONTINUING CASE AND SUSPENSION OF LICENSE

This matter came on for hearing before the Real Estate Commission, Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Commission"), during a regular agenda on February 22, 2023, at the Nevada State Business Center, 3300 W. Sahara Avenue, Nevada Room, Suite 400, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102.¹ The RESPONDENT, KEA RANA (hereinafter, "RESPONDENT" or "RANA") was represented by counsel Gregory Wilde, Esq. Phil W. Su, Esq., Senior Deputy Attorney General with the Nevada Attorney General's Office, appeared on behalf of the Real Estate Division of the Department of Business and Industry, State of Nevada (the "Division").

On Sunday, February 19, 2023, RESPONDENT's counsel filed a voluntary petition for Chapter 13 bankruptcy on behalf of his client in the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of Nevada under case number 23-10594-nmc. On Tuesday, February 21, 2023, RESPONDENT's counsel filed Notices of Bankruptcy with the Division in each of the RESPONDENT's matters before the Commission and indicated, in attached correspondence, that he expected the scheduled hearings would be continued as a result of an automatic stay imposed by 11 USC 362(a).

On Wednesday, February 22, 2023, Division counsel filed briefing in opposition to the requested stay, noting that 11 USC 362(b)(2)(D) provides a potential exception to the automatic stay. The Commission thereafter entertained oral argument from counsel and received further input from Commission Counsel. Upon further discussion, RESPONDENT agreed to that she would be subject to temporary suspension of her real estate licenses and permits until hearing on these matters was completed.

¹ Hearings against RESPONDENT for cases # 2021-264 and 2022-339 were also scheduled for this stacked agenda.

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
Therefore, the Commission ordered by unanimous vote as follows:

1. This matter is continued until the bankruptcy stay is lifted;
2. RESPONDENT's Nevada Real Estate Broker license (B.0049123.CORP) and property management permit (PM.0163622.BKR) are SUSPENDED until her pending matters before the Commission are heard and resolved.
