10	COMPLAINT AND	NOTICE OF HEARING
11	The REAL ESTATE DIVISION OF THE	DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY
12	OF THE STATE OF NEVADA ("Division") her	reby notifies RESPONDENT EILEEN PRUDHONT
13	("RESPONDENT") of an administrative hearing	before the STATE OF NEVADA REAL ESTATE
14	COMMISSION ("Commission"). The hearing wi	ll be held pursuant to Chapter 233B and Chapter 645
15	of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"), and Chapter 645 of the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC").	
16	The purpose of the hearing is to consider the allegations stated below and to determine if the	
17	RESPONDENT should be subject to an administr	ative penalty as set forth in NRS 645.806 (3), and the
18	discipline to be imposed, if violations of law are particular	roven.
19	JURISDICTION	
20	RESPONDENT was at all relevant times mentioned in this Complaint licensed as a Broker under	
21	license number B.1001931.LLC and holds a Business Broker Permit Number BUSB.0006956.BKR and	
22	is therefore subject to the jurisdiction of the Division and the Commission, and the provisions of NRS	
23	chapter 645 and NAC chapter 645.	
24	FACTUAL A	LLEGATIONS
25	1. The RESPONDENT is broker of	record of The Business Brokers LLC. [NRED0001-
26	0003].	
27	2. The RESPONDENT broker's licen	se was first issued in 2017. [NRED0002].
28	3. In 2021, The Division sent a courte	esy email to RESPONDENT reminding her to submit
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Trust Account Reconciliation form 546, or 546A, annually, and reminding RESPONDENT of the annual
 deadline for submitting these forms (the last day in February every year). The RESPONDENT did submit
 her 546A Affidavit form for 2022. [NRED0023].

4 4. In 2023, RESPONDENT failed to submit her mandatory 546A Affidavit form by the 5 expiration month of her broker's license (February 28, 2023). [NRED0005-0009].

5. Between April 3, 2023, and April 14, 2023, The Division sent two letters to RESPONDENT, notifying her of the \$250 fine, requesting her to complete her 546A form, and advising her of her appeal rights if she disagreed with the finding of violation and/or imposition of the fine. [NRED0005-0009].

10 6. On April 3, 2023, the Division fined RESPONDENT \$250 for failing to timely submit the
11 mandatory 546A Affidavit form pursuant to NAC 645.806(3) (3). [NRED0006-0007].

The April 3, 2023, letter was returned as undeliverable to RESPONDENT's business
address on record with the Division. [NRED0005; NRED0002-0003].

- The April 14, 2023, second letter was mailed to RESPONDENT's business address listed
 on RESPONDENT's brokerage website. [NRED0005; 0008-0009].
- 9. On May 22, 2023, the Division Investigator emailed RESPONDENT to request that she
 return her 546A form, pay the \$250.00 fine, and to advise RESPONDENT of potential fines from the
 Commission. [NRED0010-0011].
- 19 10. On May 23, 2023, RESPONDENT responded with two emails claiming RESPONDENT
 20 did not receive notification of the 2021 violation. [NRED0012-0015; 0016-0017].
- 11. In response, the Division Investigator sent a copy of the March 18, 2021, email, which
 included the investigator's reminder to submit a 546A form on an annual basis. [NRED0018-0024].
- 23 12. On May 23, 2023, The Division received the RESPONDENT's completed 546A form for
 24 2023, but did not receive the \$250 fine payment for the violation. [NRED0004].

25 13. On June 6, 2023, the Division sent an NRS 233B letter, return receipt requested, to
26 RESPONDENT stating the Division's intent to file a complaint with the Commission for violation of
27 NAC 645.804 (3). [NRED0025-0028].

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1	VIOLATIONS OF LAW	
2	RESPONDENT has committed the following violations of law:	
3	1. RESPONDENT violated NRS 645.633(1)(b) pursuant to NAC 645.806(3) by failing	
4	to timely submit her annual Form 546A Affidavit to the Division for 2023, due by the last day of the	
5	expiration month for her broker license.	
6	2. RESPONDENT violated NRS 645.633(1)(b) pursuant to NAC 645.695 by failing to	
7	pay the \$250.00 administrative fine levied by the Division for failure to timely submit the 2023 Form	
8	546A Affidavit.	
9	DISCIPLINE AUTHORIZED	
10	Pursuant to NRS 645.630, the Commission is empowered to impose an administrative fine of up	
11	to \$10,000 per violation and suspend, revoke, or place conditions on RESPONDENT'S license if	
12	warranted.	
13	Additionally, under NRS 622.400, the Commission is authorized to impose costs of the	
14	proceeding upon RESPONDENT, including investigative costs and attorney's fees, if the Commission	
15	otherwise imposes discipline on RESPONDENT.	
16	Therefore, the Division requests that the Commission take such disciplinary action as it deems	
17	appropriate under the circumstances.	
18	NOTICE OF HEARING	
19	PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that a disciplinary hearing has been set to consider the	
20	Administrative Complaint against the above-named Respondent in accordance with Chapters 233B and	
21	645 of the Nevada Revised Statutes and Chapter 645 of the Nevada Administrative Code.	
22	THE HEARING WILL TAKE PLACE on November 7, 2023, commencing at 9:00 a.m., or	
23	as soon thereafter as the Commission is able to hear the matter, and each day thereafter	
24	commencing at 9:00 a.m. through November 9, 2023, or earlier if the business of the Commission	
25	is concluded. The Commission meeting will be held on November 7, 2023, at the Nevada State	
26	Business Center, 3300 West Sahara Avenue, 4th Floor – Nevada Room, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102	
27	with video conferencing to Nevada Division of Insurance, 1818 E. College Parkway, Suite 103,	
28	Carson City Nevada 89706. The meeting will continue on each day thereafter commencing at 9:00	

a.m. through November 9, 2023, at the Nevada State Business Center, 3300 West Sahara Avenue, 4th Floor – Nevada Room, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102 with video conferencing to Nevada Division of Insurance, 1818 E. College Parkway, Suite 103, Carson City, Nevada 89706, until the business of the Commission is concluded.

STACKED CALENDAR: Your hearing is one of several hearings scheduled at the same time as part of a regular meeting of the Commission that is expected to last from November 7, 2023 through November 9, 2023, or earlier if the business of the Commission is concluded. Thus, your hearing may be continued until later in the day or from day to day. It is your responsibility to be present when your case is called. If you are not present when your hearing is called, a default may be entered against you and the Commission may decide the case as if all allegations in the complaint were true. YOUR RIGHTS AT THE HEARING: except as mentioned below, the hearing is an open meeting under Nevada's open meeting law, and may be attended by the public. After the evidence and arguments, the commission may conduct a closed meeting to discuss your alleged misconduct or professional competence. You are entitled to a copy of the transcript of the open and closed portions of the meeting, although you must pay for the transcription.

As the Respondent, you are specifically informed that you have the right to appear and be heard in your defense, either personally or through your counsel of choice. At the hearing, the Division has the burden of proving the allegations in the complaint and will call witnesses and present evidence against you. You have the right to respond and to present relevant evidence and argument on all issues involved. You have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, and cross-examine opposing witnesses on any matter relevant to the issues involved.

You have the right to request that the Commission issue subpoenas to compel witnesses to testify
and/or evidence to be offered on your behalf. In making the request, you may be required to demonstrate
the relevance of the witness' testimony and/or evidence. Other important rights you have are listed in
NRS 645.680 through 645.990, NRS Chapter 233B, and NAC 645.810 through 645.875.

2	645 and if the allegations contained herein are substantially proven by the evidence presented and to	
3	further determine what administrative penalty is to be assessed against the RESPONDENT, if any,
