COMPLAINT AND NOTICE OF HEARING

The REAL ESTATE DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA ("Division") hereby notifies RESPONDENT JOHN PRUDHONT ("RESPONDENT") of an administrative hearing before the STATE OF NEVADA REAL ESTATE COMMISSION ("Commission"). The hearing will be held pursuant to Chapter 233B and Chapter 645 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"), and Chapter 645 of the Nevada Administrative Code ("NAC"). The purpose of the hearing is to consider the allegations stated below and to determine if the RESPONDENT should be subject to an administrative penalty as set forth in NRS 645.806 (3), and the discipline to be imposed, if violations of law are proven.

JURISDICTION

RESPONDENT was at all relevant times mentioned in this Complaint licensed as a Broker under license number B.1001930.LLC and holds a Business Broker Permit Number BUSB.0006958.BKR and is therefore subject to the jurisdiction of the Division and the Commission, and the provisions of NRS chapter 645 and NAC chapter 645.

FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- 1. RESPONDENT is broker of record of The Business Brokers LLC. [NRED0001-0003].
- 2. RESPONDENT broker's license was first issued in 2017. [NRED0002].
- In 2021, The Division sent a courtesy email to RESPONDENT reminding him to submit
 Trust Account Reconciliation form 546, or 546A, annually, and reminding RESPONDENT of the annual

deadline for submitting these forms (the last day in February every year). The RESPONDENT did submit his 546A Affidavit form for 2022. [NRED0023; 0004].

- 4. In 2023, RESPONDENT failed to submit his mandatory 546A Affidavit form by the expiration month of his broker's license (February 28, 2023). [NRED0004-0009].
- 5. Between April 3, 2023, and April 16, 2023, The Division sent two letters to RESPONDENT, notifying him of the \$250 fine, requesting him to complete his 546A form, and advising him of his appeal rights if he disagreed with the finding of violation and/or imposition of the fine. [NRED0005-0009].
- 6. On April 3, 2023, the Division fined RESPONDENT \$250 for failing to timely submit the mandatory 546A Affidavit form pursuant to NAC 645.806(3). [NRED0006-0007].
- 7. The April 3, 2023, letter was returned as undeliverable to RESPONDENT's business address on record with the Division. [NRED0005; NRED0002-0003].
- 8. The April 16, 2023, second letter was mailed to RESPONDENTs business address listed on RESPONDENT's brokerage website. [NRED0005; 0008-0009].
- 9. On May 22, 2023, the Division Investigator emailed RESPONDENT to request that he return his 546A form, pay the \$250.00 fine, and to advise RESPONDENT of potential fines from the Commission. [NRED0010-0011].
- 10. On May 23, 2023, Eileen Prudhont, wife of RESPONDENT and a concurrent broker for The Business Brokers LLC with RESPONDENT, responded with two emails from RESPONDENT's email address claiming RESPONDENT did not receive notification of the 2021 violation. [NRED0012-0015; 0016-0017].
- 11. In response, the Division Investigator sent a copy of the March 18, 2021, email, which included the investigator's reminder to submit a 546A form on an annual basis. [NRED0018-0024].
- 12. On May 23, 2023, The Division received the RESPONDENT's completed 546A form for 2023, but **did not** receive the \$250 fine payment for the violation. [NRED0004].
- 13. On June 6, 2023, the Division sent an NRS 233B letter, return receipt requested, to RESPONDENT stating the Division's intent to file a complaint with the Commission for violation of NAC 645.804 (3). [NRED0025-0028].

VIOLATIONS OF LAW

RESPONDENT has committed the following violations of law:

- 1. RESPONDENT violated NRS 645.633(1)(b) pursuant to NAC 645.806(3) by failing to timely submit his annual Form 546A Affidavit to the Division for 2023, due by the last day of the expiration month for his broker license.
- 2. RESPONDENT violated NRS 645.633(1)(b) pursuant to NAC 645.695 by failing to pay the \$250.00 administrative fine levied by the Division for failure to timely submit the 2023 Form 546A Affidavit.

DISCIPLINE AUTHORIZED

Pursuant to NRS 645.630, the Commission is empowered to impose an administrative fine of up to \$10,000 per violation and suspend, revoke, or place conditions on RESPONDENT'S license if warranted.

Additionally, under NRS 622.400, the Commission is authorized to impose costs of the proceeding upon RESPONDENT, including investigative costs and attorney's fees, if the Commission otherwise imposes discipline on RESPONDENT.

Therefore, the Division requests that the Commission take such disciplinary action as it deems appropriate under the circumstances.

NOTICE OF HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that a disciplinary hearing has been set to consider the Administrative Complaint against the above-named Respondent in accordance with Chapters 233B and 645 of the Nevada Revised Statutes and Chapter 645 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

THE HEARING WILL TAKE PLACE on November 7, 2023, commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the Commission is able to hear the matter, and each day thereafter commencing at 9:00 a.m. through November 9, 2023, or earlier if the business of the Commission is concluded. The Commission meeting will be held on November 7, 2023, at the Nevada State Business Center, 3300 West Sahara Avenue, 4th Floor – Nevada Room, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102 with video conferencing to Nevada Division of Insurance, 1818 E. College Parkway, Suite 103, Carson City, Nevada 89706. The meeting will continue on each day thereafter commencing at 9:00

a.m. through November 9, 2023, at the Nevada State Business Center, 3300 West Sahara Avenue, 4th Floor – Nevada Room, Las Vegas, Nevada 89102 with video conferencing to Nevada Division of Insurance, 1818 E. College Parkway, Suite 103, Carson City, Nevada 89706, until the business of the Commission is concluded.

STACKED CALENDAR: Your hearing is one of several hearings scheduled at the same time as part of a regular meeting of the Commission that is expected to last from November 7, 2023 through November 9, 2023, or earlier if the business of the Commission is concluded. Thus, your hearing may be continued until later in the day or from day to day. It is your responsibility to be present when your case is called. If you are not present when your hearing is called, a default may be entered against you and the Commission may decide the case as if all allegations in the complaint were true. If you have any questions please call Kelly Valadez, Commission Coordinator (702) 486-4606.

YOUR RIGHTS AT THE HEARING: except as mentioned below, the hearing is an open meeting under Nevada's open meeting law, and may be attended by the public. After the evidence and arguments, the commission may conduct a closed meeting to discuss your alleged misconduct or professional competence. You are entitled to a copy of the transcript of the open and closed portions of the meeting, although you must pay for the transcription.

As the Respondent, you are specifically informed that you have the right to appear and be heard in your defense, either personally or through your counsel of choice. At the hearing, the Division has the burden of proving the allegations in the complaint and will call witnesses and present evidence against you. You have the right to respond and to present relevant evidence and argument on all issues involved. You have the right to call and examine witnesses, introduce exhibits, and cross-examine opposing witnesses on any matter relevant to the issues involved.

You have the right to request that the Commission issue subpoenas to compel witnesses to testify and/or evidence to be offered on your behalf. In making the request, you may be required to demonstrate the relevance of the witness' testimony and/or evidence. Other important rights you have are listed in NRS 645.680 through 645.990, NRS Chapter 233B, and NAC 645.810 through 645.875.

3	to further determine what administrative penalty is to be assessed against the RESPONDENT, if any,
4	pursuant to NRS 645.235, 645.633 and or 645.630.
