12 **OPPOSITION TO RESPONDENT'S REQUEST FOR
13 RECONSIDERATION OF PAYMENT PLAN**

14 The REAL ESTATE DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY
15 OF THE STATE OF NEVADA ("Division"), by and through its attorneys of record, Aaron D. Ford,
16 Attorney General, and Christal P. Keegan, Deputy Attorney General, brings this Opposition to
17 Respondent's Request for Reconsideration of Repayment Plan.

1 **I. BACKGROUND**

2 These cases have been going on for over a year now since the Division filed its Complaints for
3 disciplinary action against the Respondent Marshall Carrasco (“Carrasco”) on March 28, 2023 and March
4 29, 2023, in Case No. 2021-1122 2022-120 and Case No. 2022-120, respectively. Here we are again,
5 back before the Commission because Carrasco refuses to accept the Commission’s Orders. *Exhibit 1.*

6 As you know, it was this very Commission that heard Carrasco’s Petition Request for Rehearing
7 at its November 7, 2023 Meeting whereby it affirmed its August 31, 2023 default Orders. Then, again at
8 its meeting commencing on February 20, 2024, this Commission heard Carrasco’s Motion for
9 Reconsideration of Discipline, where it modified the Orders revoking his licenses, but affirmed that the
10 assessed administrative fines and the Division’s incurred costs in the total amount of \$103,366.77 due
11 within 90 days. *Exhibit 2.*

12 Despite having two attorneys appearing on his behalf at the February 20, 2024 Commission
13 Meeting, it is unexplainable why Carrasco or his attorneys did not raise this motion for a repayment plan
14 during the hearing.¹ Instead, Carrasco comes back to this Commission time and time again,
15 while continuing to advance filings in his pursuit of his now erroneous appeal before the District Court.
16 *Exhibit 3.*

17 Further, Carrasco’s payment is not due until July 5, 2024 and therefore his request lacks standing.
18 Carrasco’s reconsideration request is premature since the reinstatement of his licenses effective April 5,
19 2024 provides a full 90 days to resume his career and earn a living prior to his payment due date. Lastly,
20 Carrasco has failed his burden of proof as his request fails to provide any financial insights into his ability
21 to pay.

22 Therefore, the Division files this Opposition to his Request for Reconsideration and requests the
23 Commission standby its Order Granting Motion for Reconsideration filed March 6, 2024.

24 **II. LEGAL ARGUMENT**

25 Nowhere in NRS 645 and NAC 645 does it mention the procedure for a reconsideration request.
26 Therefore, looking at the Nevada Administrative Procedures Act under NRS 233B, specifically NRS
27 233B.130, in relevant part under subsection 4 scantily addresses the timeliness of such requests:

1 **NRS 233B.130 Judicial review; requirements for petition and cross-**
2 **petition; statement of intent to participate; petition for rehearing or**
3 **reconsideration; service; dismissal of certain agencies and persons**
 from proceedings concerning final decision of State Contractors'
 Board; exclusive means.

4 4. A petition for rehearing or reconsideration must be filed within 15
5 days after the date of service of the final decision. An order granting or
6 denying the petition must be served on all parties at least 5 days before the
7 expiration of the time for filing the petition for judicial review. If the
 petition is granted, the subsequent order shall be deemed the final order for
 the purpose of judicial review.

8 Pursuant to NRS 233B.135(2), the burden of proof is on the party attacking or resisting the
9 decision to show that the final decision is invalid, and therefore it is Carrasco's burden.

10 **A. Carrasco's request fails his burden of proof.**

11 Despite it being his burden of proof, Carrasco does not include any support for his request for a
12 repayment plan. Carrasco's request fails to provide any financial insights into his ability to pay the Total
13 Amount due. Carrasco's request fails to present any plan to pay back the Total Amount due. Instead,
14 Carrasco's request for a repayment plan propounds the Commission with this task, blindfolded.

15 **B. Carrasco's request to vacate a specific portion of its Order fails to allege any cause**
16 **or grounds which entitle him to a reconsideration.**

17 Carrasco's reconsideration request does not allege the March 6, 2024 Order substantially
18 prejudiced his rights, nor does he allege any violation of constitutional or statutory provisions; no excess
19 of the statutory authority by the agency; no unlawful procedure; no other error of law; not clearly
20 erroneous in view of the reliable, probative and substantial evidence on the whole record; nor that the
21 Commission acted in any arbitrary or capricious manner or characterized by abuse of discretion, that may
22 otherwise entitle him to a reconsideration.

23 Carrasco cannot overcome the fact that the total amount due within 90 days of the effective date
24 was properly ordered, therefore the Commission should uphold its March 6, 2024 Order.

1 **C. Carrasco’s request to vacate a specific portion of its Order fails to demonstrate that**
2 **the Commissioner’s Decision was Arbitrary or Capricious or Characterized by**
3 **Abuse of Discretion.**

4 Carrasco has not supplemented the record with the transcript from the February 20, 2024
5 Commission Meeting.² Nonetheless, the existing record clearly reflects that the Commissioners have
6 given consideration and regard to the facts and circumstances in rendering the fines and costs imposed,
7 therefore it did not act in an arbitrary and capricious manner:

8 Commission President Gurr stated: “I think that we’re required as brokers with licensees under
9 our umbrella to, it’s incumbent on us as brokers with licensees under our umbrella to make sure that all
10 of them are in compliance, their licenses are good, remind them when they need to get renewed, all those
11 types of things, and his statement and his kind of email response that Ms. Keegan allowed him to use as
12 a response to the complaint was that, it’s not his fault.”³

13 Commissioner Vice President Plummer stated: “it was a large default because he chose not to be
14 present, regardless of where he was in the world. I believe, we all believe that he had the ability to be
15 present for that, and he should have understood the circumstances of his failure to attend after given a
16 continuance per his request.”⁴

17 Commissioner Roth stated: “I hate to impose such a severe penalty, but yeah, I can understand
18 why such is the case.”⁵

19 Commissioner Ruthe stated: “The violations were quite harsh also. ... I don’t think we need to
20 discuss it again. His violations were pretty strong, and he never showed, came in on a zoom or discussed
21 it, and now when we’re at this point...”⁶

22 Commissioner Tina stated: “Just a point in fact, Attorney Keegan, how long did this go on? Was
23 it over a year that he was unlicensed selling?” Response: February 2021 to February 2022. “Okay.
24 That’s just a point.”



12 **ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

13 On November 28, 2023, Respondent Marshall Carrasco filed his Motion for Reconsideration of
14 Discipline and, Alternatively Petition for Rehearing. On December 1, 2023, the Petitioner Sharath
15 Chandra, Administrator of the Real Estate Division, Department of Business and Industry of the State of
16 Nevada ("Division") filed its Motion to Dismiss Respondent's Motion for Reconsideration of Discipline
and, Alternatively Petition for Rehearing.

17 The matter came before the Nevada Real Estate Commission ("Commission") for hearing on
18 Tuesday, February 20, 2024. Respondent appeared and was represented by counselors Hal Taylor, and
19 by way of Motion to Associate Counsel filed February 15, 2024, Robert Merlo of Wilson Elser LLP,
20 Illinois Attorney No. 6327312. Deputy Attorney General, Christal P. Keegan, appeared on behalf of
21 the Division.

22 The matter having been submitted for decision based on the Commission's consideration of the
23 oral arguments presented during the hearing and the filed documents, the Commission now enters
24 its Order.

25 **ORDER**

26 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent's Motion for Reconsideration of Discipline is
