

12 **ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY STAY**

13 The matter came before the Nevada Real Estate Commission (“Commission”) during its  
14 three-day hearing stack commencing May 13, 2025 through May 15, 2025. The matter was called on  
15 Tuesday, May 13, 2025, whereby the Commission was informed the day before, on May 12, 2025, the  
16 Nevada Court of Appeals issued a Temporary Stay of Respondent Andrew Arevalo’s (“Arevalo”) May  
17 13 Hearing before the Commission upon his emergency petition just filed on May 9, 2025 in Case No.  
18 90605-COA, following the Eighth Judicial District Court’s denial of his Petition for Writ of Mandamus  
19 in its entirety at the hearing on May 6, 2025 in Case No. A-25-917222-W.

20 Based on the Temporary Stay the Commission now enters its Order.

21 **ORDER**

22 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent’s Case No. 2024-660 is TEMPORARILY  
23 STAYED from the May 13 Hearing, and the matter shall be heard at the August 12-14, 2025 Commission  
24 Hearings in Carson City, Nevada.
