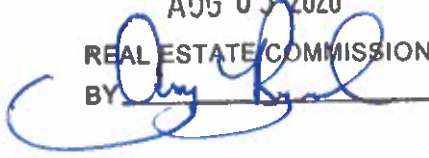

Real Estate Commissioners,

After reviewing the documents sent to me it is clear that you have everything but my side of what happened.

My husband and I run a tattoo shop in the Las Vegas Valley. We have been open since 2021. In March of 2024 we were asked to host a Pop up party where they sell Marijuana and mushrooms. We made the bad decision to allow this party to happen at our establishment. Unbeknownst to us, the people who asked us to throw the party were under investigation and the party was raided.

The two people in charge of the party were Jose Miguel Madrigal and Nawai Alyssa Kanani. They were a couple that we befriended and had been traveling all over Mexico with. We had known them since 2021 when we were building our shop. We trusted and cared about them and their children.

During the raid they stated that they were just customers and they were released. We on the other hand were the owners of the shop and with that being said we took the charges. After being released from jail we talked to Miguel and Alyssa and Miguel stated he would take the charges and tell them it was his party. This did not happen when our lawyer asked for a confession he declined. I honestly thought that they would take ownership of their party.

We tried to fight the case for 1.5 years. I tried to cooperate with the police but they did not want to hear what I had to say. They thought we were running the operation. They thought we were the bosses of it all and honestly we were just the location. They thought this so much that a month after the raid at the shop they came to our home in Boulder City and raided it also. They found my guns and some mushrooms for personal use. Due to me being a felon I am not supposed to have guns. I purchased them during COVID and have had them since then. I was working on getting my record sealed with my Lawyer Robert Langford. He had tried once and was getting ready to submit again. When we caught these new charges.

I was sentenced to a year in prison and my husband was sentenced to probation. Honestly I was bitter after this all happened. I was mad at myself and the couple. But honestly this is my fault I knew better and I know better. I am responsible for my own actions and my actions were wrong. I have lost my Real Estate License, my Career and a year of my life I can never get back. I am truly disappointed in myself and the choices I made.

I am wrong that I did not report this to the Real Estate Division.. I am wrong because I should have never made a decision to allow this type of thing to happen in my establishment and I am wrong for having Guns when I know that I am not allowed to have them.

I can only ask that my Real Estate License not be permanently revoked and that I do not have to pay a huge fine. I am wrong for my actions and I am still paying the price. I hope in one year from now I can reapply to get my license back, and be a part of the Real Estate community I love so much.
